2017 RECAP

Our 2017 year revolved around a massive trip for us Berry's to get to Capetown, South Africa in July to pour into several churches and a ministry school that hosts students from all over Africa to be equipped over a two week stretch. Through equipping and impartation, we helped send these word changers on the streets to see dozens of miracles and salvations in just a few days!

In February, we visited the beautiful country of Jamaica where the Lord brought us into an amazing new relationship with one of the leading fathers over the Island. Through a training seminar on street evangelism we took the core 100 leaders of a 3000 person church personally on the streets to see many people be healed, saved and delivered.

In May we visited Lethbridge, Alberta, Canada for the 2nd time and also did a training seminar in healing and prophetic ministry. It was a fruitful time bringing some of our ministry school students with us to help lead the teams. In California we visited good friends in cities in our home town and also made it out to Utah, Pennyslvania, New Jersey, North Carolina, & South Carolina. It was a joy to connect with Catch the Fire in Raleigh and give away to these churches a fresh experience of the presence of God. Timothy launched three schools of ministry in Bakersfield with 17 1st year students, 25 2nd year and 6 in the leadership program.

[Elizabeth] The Lord gave me a fresh word of encouragement for the Church for 2018 and I pray it releases you into a new and fresh experience of intimacy with our Father.

Let's say you've invited a person you love and adore to come to your house Saturday morning for a fresh cup of tea. In preparation, you tidied up a little, made sure your surroundings looked presentable, made sure you looked presentable and maybe even said a little prayer. "Ding-dong," rings the doorbell. What do you do?

- Don't answer. They came: that's enough right?
- Quickly open the door, freak out and slam the door.
- Open the door but don't say a word. Leave them standing in the doorway.
- Invite them in and to have a seat. Then leave and stare them down from the kitchen.

- Ask, "Why are you here? I really didn't expect you to show up." Invite them in with an, "I'm so glad you came," and offer the tea you promised. Greet them with a thankful hug, offer the tea you promised, and ask, "What's on your heart for today?"

Often when we invite God to come and meet with us we don't know how to respond. And sometimes, when he shows up, we don't even show up to our own invitation! I can think of countless times when I've worshiped and sang words like, "Come Lord Jesus," or "Holy Spirit you are welcome here." But where was I present? How was I positioned to welcome them? Did I even show up? In Matthew 7:7-8, it is written, "Ask and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened..." When we ask Him to come, He will come. He shows up. My question to you is: Are you showing up to your own invitation? I believe this is a loving challenge from the Lord for this coming year. Now more than ever, let Him in and be ready for Him! The more we seek him... the more we find him. (Deut 4:29)
